

No. 16 ESCAPE TO COOKHAM ISLAND

KM	Miles	Direction
0	0.0	At Iver railway station turn left and ride along a footpath through trees
0.1	0.1	At the end of the footpath, turn left onto the bridge over the railway line
0.5	0.3	Continue on, either on the road or the footway on the left side of the road
0.7	0.4	Just before the bridge over the canal, turn left along a track down to the canal towpath
		Continue along the towpath, riding west (away from the bridge)
4.1	2.6	Cross under two bridges over the canal, and just before the third bridge, turn left onto Cycle Route 61
4.2	2.6	Ride across the cycle/pedestrian bridge over the railway line
4.3	2.7	Emerging onto the road in a housing estate, turn right onto Minster Way
4.7	2.9	At the end of Minster Way, cross the road onto the cycle path (🚲 Cycle Route 61)
		Keep following the cycle route and cross the A4 by the pedestrian/cycle crossing
5.6	3.5	After crossing the A4, turn left then right onto Cedar Way (🚲 Jubilee River)
5.8	3.6	At the end of Cedar Way, continue on through the gate and into the park
6	3.8	Turn right onto an unsurfaced cycle path (🚲 Cycle Route 61)
		Follow the cycle path through the park, with the playing fields on your right
		Follow the cycle path through the sports ground car park and continue along the surfaced cycle path (🚲 Cycle Route 61)
8.5	5.3	When you reach a BMX track, turn left and cross by bridge over the M4
8.9	5.6	Cross Datchet Road and continue along The Myrke (🚲 Cycle Route 61)
9.1	5.7	By the red letter box, turn left onto the cycle path
9.2	5.8	After crossing the Jubilee River, turn right (🚲 Cycleway)
		Follow the cycle route all the way along the Jubilee River
18	11.2	After crossing the bridge over the river, turn left onto a narrow lane
18	11.4	At the end of the lane, turn left onto the A4 (Bath Road)
19	11.9	Cross the bridge over the River Thames and turn right at the roundabout (🚲 Cookham)
19	12.1	Turn left onto Ray Park Road (🚲 Gravel Pit)
		Keep following the road ahead
21	12.8	Turn left onto Ray Mill Road West
20	12.5	Turn right onto a cycle path (🚲 Cycle Route 50 / Cookham)
		Follow Cycle Route 50 past the lakes and through the fields

24	14.9	At the end of the cycle path, turn right onto Lightlands Lane
24	15.1	At the T-junction with the Maidenhead Road, turn right
25	15.5	At the mini-roundabout turn right (🚲 Cookham B4447)
26	16.2	In the centre of Cookham Village , turn left (🚲 Bourne End)
28	17.6	For Cookham Lock , turn immediately right onto Odney Lane and follow the path ahead
		Cross the Thames and continue along Ferry Lane towards Bourne End
29	18.1	<i>Easy to miss!</i> Turn right onto Hedsor Road
30	18.6	At the T-junction turn right onto Hedsor Hill
31	19.6	At the T-junction turn left (🚲 Littleworth Common)
33	20.7	At the T-junction, turn right (no signpost)
34	21.0	At the T-junction, turn left (🚲 Burnham Beeches)
34	21.1	Take the second turning to the right onto Boveney Wood Lane
		For Littleworth Common and the Blackwood Arms, take the next right turn (no signpost)
35	21.6	At the three-way junction, bear right (🚲 Burnham Beeches)
36	22.3	When you reach a small car park on the left, turn left and ride along the cycle/pedestrian path through Burnham Beeches
		You should end up at the main visitors' centre, from where you rejoin the road, continuing along Lord Mayor's Drive
38	23.4	At the four-way junction, turn left (🚲 Egypt)
40	24.7	At the A355, turn left then immediately right onto Parish Lane
40	25.1	At the four-way junction, turn left onto Andrew Hill Lane
		Shortcut to the One Pin Pub, bypassing Hedgerley and the White Horse pub: carry straight on along Parish Lane
41	25.5	At the bottom of the hill, turn right onto Kiln Lane
41	25.9	<i>At the T-junction, turn left for the White Horse pub, otherwise, turn right to continue the ride</i>
42	26.4	At The One Pin pub turn left onto Collum Green Road
44	27.5	<i>Easy to miss!</i> Take the first turning to the right (no signpost)
47	29.1	At the T-junction, turn left
44	27.5	<i>Easy to miss!</i> Take the first right turn onto Duffield Lane
47	29.1	At the T-junction, turn left onto Park Road
47	29.6	At the four-way junction, turn right (🚲 Stoke Poges Church / Slough)
		Continue along Stoke Poges Lane into Slough
50	30.9	At the traffic lights, turn left onto Elliman Avenue
50	31.4	At the traffic lights, turn right onto Stoke Road
51	31.9	Just after the railway bridge, dismount and turn left along Brunel Way, walking bikes along the pavement as it's a one-way street
51	32.0	Slough railway station is on your left
